## **School Supply Kits!**

Streamline your back-to-school supply shopping in the upcoming year! We are pleased to work with 1<sup>st</sup> Day School Supplies to provide kits tailored to grade-specific needs! Selecting this service is voluntary and families may still choose to buy supplies independently and bring them to Book Day. All interested in these pre-fabricated kits may follow these steps:

1. Go to [www.1stdayschoolsupplies.com](http://www.1stdayschoolsupplies.com) and enter the school zip code: 23226.
2. Click on Supply Kits under Saint Bridget School.
3. 3. Select the kit that corresponds to your child's upcoming grade. NOTE: For 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students enrolled in Learning Strategies, choose "7<sup>th</sup> Learning Strategies" or "8<sup>th</sup> Learning Strategies". These kits have some extra supplies for the Learning Strategies classes. If you don't know if your student will take those classes, choose the basic kit. You may need to pick up an extra binder and an extra pack of index cards if your child enrolls in Learning Strategies.
4. Review the items in the kit by rolling over the individual items. All supplies are name brand.
5. IMPORTANT: Because some supplies are "reusable", like calculators and headphones, and others are Saint Bridget School specific (such as rest mats and book socks) there are notes at the bottom of each grade indicating additional supplies that MUST be purchased outside of the basic kit. Please read these notes carefully or your child will be missing important supplies.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Day School Supplies sells some of these items, as you will see listed at the top of the "main kit" list. You can add those items on to your order or purchase them independently.
  - Other items, as always, will be available for purchase at Book Day.
6. For each kit you'd like to purchase, enter your child's name, grade, and gender. Add the kit to your cart and you will see a pop-up asking if you'd like to add on additional kits, calculators, headphones, earbuds, or Under Armour accessories. You may select any of these items or proceed to checkout.

All boxes will ship directly to the school and will be labeled with your child's name and placed in your child's classroom by Book Day. This is not currently a fundraiser, but simply a service offered for the parents of the school. To help support the school administration during this
