## School Supplies: Liv Schneider (not present, reported by Amanda Graziano)

- Liv has given Mrs. Dingus last year's list to distribute to teachers. As in the past, they can just hand write addendums and changes and send them back to Liv.
- Amanda read the following message to PTO: Prices have increased for Lysol (I've been told they've contracted with Lysol and so these should be branded wipes) and Purell. Also, the prices reflected (at the top of each page) reflect our *existing \$5 fundraising fee* and a *new \$7 ship to home fee* which has been negotiated (thought not yet reflected) down to \$6. These 2 changes mean each year has gone up between 12-18%. A service that seemed very reasonable, now seems a bit pricey. As a reminder, we earned \$758 in 2019 and it should have been similar in 2020. I'm waiting for that number. I would recommend that this year we remove the fundraising fee and keep the \$6 ship to home fee. I know this means a loss of fundraising dollars, but the higher prices really are a big jump in one year and the program needs to be sustainable both from a parent cost and a PTO workload standpoint. The new price would be \$6 less than what is currently listed at the top of the page (\$1 negotiated decrease in shipping + \$5 loss of fundraising dollars).
- The group discussed and would like to keep some of the money as fundraising, citing that parents will pay for the convenience. Amanda will talk to Liv.
- After discussing with Liv, we decided to not give the option to ship to home and just to ship to school again this year. This will make the price for the parents only a slight increase but enable us to earn some money for the PTO.
