Dear Rising Second Graders and Parents,

Your children have grown to be great readers this year. They have gained many reading skills that should be practiced over the summer. Summer reading can bridge the end of one school year and the beginning of the next. Ideally, your child should read at least 15 minutes each day in order to keep skills sharp.

Rising second graders are asked to keep a record of their summer reading on a reading log. Students may create their own log or download one from the internet. We encourage students to read a variety of books from different genres (fiction, nonfiction, fantasy, poetry, mysteries, etc.) **The completed reading logs should be returned to school on Book Day.** This will be part of our school bulletin board to celebrate summer reading.

Also, we ask that you **take a picture of your child enjoying a good book** over the summer. This picture could be taken on vacation or in your own backyard under a favorite tree. Be creative and have fun!
