Work is important in God's plan for adults and their families, so jobs and pay should be fair.



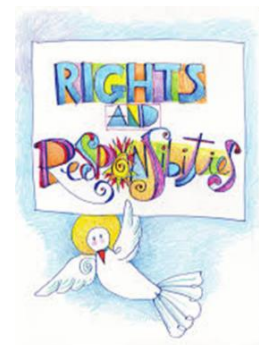
Call to Family, Community, and Participation

God made everyone so we are all brothers and sisters in God's family wherever we live.



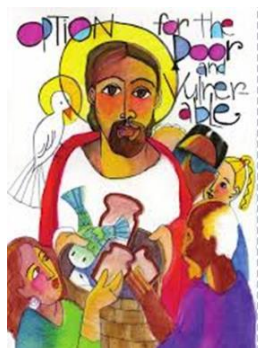
Rights and Responsibilities
